SBCCD Names New Presidents for Crafton Hills and San Bernardino Valley Colleges

The Board of Trustees of the San Bernardino Community College District (SBCCD) named Dr. Wei Zhou as the new president of Crafton Hills College (CHC) and Diana Rodriguez as the new president for San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC) at its regular meeting on June 9. Both will start their positions in early July.

\$40 Million Annually to Provide Grants to Community College Districts

AB 2017 (McCarty) would use Proposition 63 funding to provide grants for higher education mental health services. The total funding would be \$40 million annually to provide grants to community college districts, CSU and UC of up to \$5 million each. I will keep you apprised of this bill as more information is available.

1,909 SBCCD Students Do Not Meet New Board of Governor's Waiver Requirements

As you know, effective the fall of 2016, new guidelines apply to the eligibility of Board of Governor (BOG) waivers that can have a negative impact on our students. Under the new legal requirements, students would lose eligibility for the BOG if they were on probation for not maintaining a 2.0 GPA for two consecutive primary terms or not successfully completing half the units attempted in that period.

CHC and SBVC Campus Construction Schedules & Maps

Both campuses are undergoing extensive construction. The link is intended to help students and employees know when and where the construction will be for the next few months.

Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Training May Impact Access to Business & Fiscal Services Staff

As we continue our work to implement a new ERP across the district, Intensive training sessions for the new Oracle-based information system means that many of the Business & Fiscal Services staff will be away from their desk for extended periods of time. We will make sure that all phones are answered and callers are responded to in a timely manner.

The Board of Trustees of the San Bernardino Community College District is the governing body of the District. The Board is established by, and derives its power and duties from, the Constitution of the State of California and the Statutes of California as adopted by the Legislature and issued in the California Education Code, and the directives of the Board of Governors, California Community Colleges, listed in Title V, California Code of Regulations.

Seven trustees, elected from your communities, and two student representatives elected by their respective campuses govern the San Bernardino Community College District. Trustees serve a four-year term, while the non-voting student trustees serve a one-year term.

All regular and special meetings of the Board, except as otherwise required or permitted by law, are open to the public so that citizens may have the benefit of Board deliberations concerning items under consideration.
