Identity Theft Scams

WHAT IS PHISHING?

Phishing (pronounced "fishing") is a computer scam criminals use to trick persons using the Internet to disclose vital financial and personal information such as Social Security numbers, account numbers and passwords.

WHAT IS PHARMING?

Pharming (pronounced "farming") is the latest cyberswindle which threatens to harvest entire fields of victims. Pharmers redirect Internet users from legitimate commercial websites to counterfeit web pages to trick them to disclose their vital financial and personal information. Be careful while using the internet to shop.
