Various tools are available that lets you track your lost phone--or remove the data from it if necessary. If you have an iPhone, Find My iPhone (free) provides these services. If you're on Android, you have more options. One of which is Lookout Mobile Security, which provides a number of security tools to keep you and your data safe, and lets you track your phone's location. If you upgrade to the premium version (\$30 per year), you'll also get the ability to erase the data on your phone should it fall into the wrong hands.
