STALKING SAFETY TIPS

Protect yourself against stalking

- 1. Vary routes when going to class if possible.
- 2. Google your name and see what types of personal information can be easily retrieved online.
- 3. Limit the amount of very personal information (address, class schedule, etc.) on Web sites such as Facebook and MySpace.

What to do if you are being stalked

- 1. Documentation is crucial: Keep a detailed chronological summary of events, save e-mails and acquire caller identify cation.
- 2. Express your concern: Tell the stalker to stop one time and have no further contact. The person must know their be havior was unwanted if the case goes to court.
- 3. Inform your loved ones: Give them a description of the per son's appearance.
- 4. Get the law involved: Inform the police.
