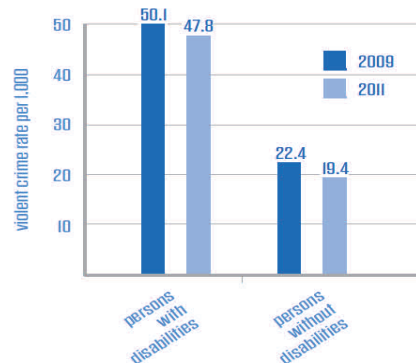

Persons with disabilities are victimized by crime at much higher rates than the rest of the population, and they are often targeted specifically because of their disabilities. Violent crimes against these victims, the majority of whom are over 50, include rape/sexual assault, robbery, aggravated assault, and intimate partner violence. As compared to other population groups, victims with disabilities experience higher rates of victimization by persons known to them, and they report crime less frequently, often because of the nature of their disabilities, such as mental disabilities or physical or emotional illness. Responding to crime victims with disabilities poses unique challenges to the criminal justice system, which is often not equipped to meet their needs.

If you are a victim of crime, you may have to cope with challenges you never expected to face. You may have been wounded or lost property you can't afford to replace. You may be overwhelmed by fear or anger. And you may not know what to do next or where to turn for help. Victim advocates can help you figure out what steps to take and what choices you may need to make. Victim advocates include paid and unpaid service providers working in a variety of settings to respond to crime victims' mental, physical, financial, social, emotional needs. Advocates can offer advice on how to stay safe and give you information on medical, mental health, and victim services in your community. Below are some of the options you may want to explore, either on your own or with the help of a victim advocate.

Emergency Preparedness

This Week: Seven Steps to Earthquake Safety: STEP 6: Improve safety immediately after an earthquake by evacuation if necessary, helping the injured and preventing further injuries or damage. The moment the ground stops shaking it is important to take action quickly and safely. First, take care of your own situation. Check for injuries and damages that need immediate attention. Evacuate your home or office only if there is damage to the building or the surrounding area is unsafe. Consider relocation somewhere safer such as a friend's house or a community shelter. If the building is undamaged, it can be safe to remain even if the power is out, but you will want to find an alternative location is power is not restored within a few days. If you have training in first aid use it to assist those who may be injured. Look around your environment to identify any new hazards such as leaking gas lines, damage to the building, water or electric lines, or other things that may be dangerous, especially if there are aftershocks. Be prepared to report damage to city or county government. Remember your emergency plans. Aftershocks may cause additional damage or items to fall, so get to a safe location. Remember to use your "grab-and-go" disaster supplies as needed.
