In 1962, President Kennedy proclaimed May 15 as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15 falls, as National Police Week. Established by a joint resolution of Congress in 1962, National Police Week pays special recognition to those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others.

California Peace Officers Memorial Foundation

Each year during the week of May 15, groups of people gather together to honor the memory of fallen officers. Surviving spouses, parents who have lost a son or daughter, children missing a parent, brothers, sisters and fellow peace officers - so many of us commemorate National Police Week by participating in a Peace Officers Memorial Service.

California Peace Officers Memorial Ceremonies have been conducted in the State Capital since 1977. It is a ceremony that honors the officers who have fallen in the line-of-duty the preceding year, recognizing the sacrifice of those loved and left behind.

"We pledge our best efforts to stand behind the men and women who stand behind the badge," said then Gov. George Deukmejian in dedicating the memorial. "The job of a peace officer is perhaps the most difficult and challenging one of all in our society. We are thankful to those who are willing to risk injury and even death in order to provide greater protection and safety for all of us."

California Peace Officers Memorial Monument
