Campus Safety tips

1. Get to know the campus safety office

Find out where it's located and become familiar with the safety services it offers. The campus safety office is also a great place to pick up safety and security tips that are specific to your campus and learn about the most common campus crimes (and how to protect yourself from them).

2. Never walk alone at night.

It's great that you feel comfortable on campus, but you can't let your guard down. Whether you're headed to grab a late night snack or meeting an evening study group at the library, ask a friend to walk with you whenever you head out at night and always stay on well-lit walkways. If you can't find someone to go with you, then call campus police at 909-384-4491 and ask for an escort.

3. Take advantage of the campus escort service.

Although it's free, chances are you're probably hesitant to use your campus' escort service. That could be because it feels a bit embarrassing to ask for help, but ask anyone who has been a victim and they'll tell you they wished they had made the call.

4. Be aware of your surroundings.

Being aware of what's happening around you means don't wear headphones and don't text! Make note of where campus emergency phones are located and if you feel like you're being followed head to a populated area like the gym or cafeteria. Above all, walk with confidence, with your head up and eyes looking around you, and always trust your instincts. If you're getting a bad vibe about someone or a situation, there's probably good reason for it.

5. Take a self-defense class.

Male or female, big or small, taking a self-defense class is time well spent. These days, many colleges offer free on-campus classes and some can even earn you credit hours. Grab a handful of pals and sign up together. You'll learn important safety tips and self-defense moves, plus enjoy a good time while doing so.
