## PHISHING & CYBER ATTACKS

*Phishing Attacks! Identity Theft! Email Scams*

The threat of computer crime or cyber attack is incredibly serious and growing. Cyber intrusions are becoming more commonplace and extremely sophisticated. Colleges and universities are targeted for their cutting-edge research and development, citizens are targeted by fraudsters and identity thieves, and children are targeted by online predators. Some attacks take down vital systems, disrupting and sometimes disabling the work of hospitals, banks, and 9-1-1 services around the country. Billions of dollars are lost every year repairing systems hit by such attacks. Who is behind such attacks? It runs the gamut — from rings of criminals wanting to steal your personal information and sell it on black markets to computer geeks looking for bragging rights to spies and terrorists looking to rob our nation of vital information or launch cyber strikes.

### 1) The email asks you to confirm personal information

Often an email will arrive in your inbox that looks very authentic. Keep an eye out for emails requesting you to confirm personal information that you would never usually provide, such as banking detail or login credentials.

### 2) The web and email addresses do not look genuine

It is often the case that a phishing email will come from an address that appears to be genuine, but take a moment to actually examine the email address. Malicious links can also be concealed within the body of email text. Before clicking on links, hover over and inspect each one first.

### 3) The email is poorly written

Read the email and check for spelling and grammatical mistakes, as well as strange or odd phrases. If you have received an unexpected email from a company, and it is riddled with mistakes, this can be a strong indicator it is actually a phish.

### 4) There is a suspicious attachment

If you receive an unexpected email from a company that contains an attachment, alarm bells should ring. The attachment could install a virus or malware on your PC or network. It is always a good practice to scan it first using anti virus software.

### 5) The message is designed to make you panic

It is common for phishing emails to instill panic in the recipient. Ensure that you take the time to really think about whether an email is asking something reasonable of you. When in doubt, throw it out! Even when you know the source, if something looks suspicious, delete it.
