

PARKING & TRAFFIC INFORMATION

With the start of the Fall semester, the SBCCD Police Department (PD) would like to welcome back students, faculty, and staff. In an effort to assist everyone returning to the campuses, as well as provide them with the basic information needed to properly drive and park on all SBCCD properties, the SBCCD PD wants to advise everyone of the following:

Parking Decals/Permits

- Student parking permits are **NOT** required until next Fall semester, specifically August 2023, and all Ticket Vending Machines will be closed
- Staff existing parking permits will be honored and are valid until next year August 2023
- Motorcycle and other two-wheeled powered vehicles parking in designated motorcycle parking areas do not require a permit

Traffic Regulations

- All drivers must obey posted speed limits, regulatory signs, and postings
- The speed limit in all parking lots is a maximum of 5 miles per hour
- To protect your vehicle and its contents, LOCK IT, HIDE IT, KEEP IT!

Designated Parking Areas

- Students, dependents, and relatives of employees are prohibited from using any staff parking lots
- Students and staff members are prohibited from parking vehicles in parking stalls marked for visitors
- No person shall park in an area posted or marked for “Disabled Parking Only” unless a valid State issued disabled person placard is displayed on the vehicle
