BLACK HISTORY MONTH



As we celebrate Black History Month here in the United States, it's a good time to reflect on black history in law enforcement.

Numerous resources cite Wiley Overton as the first black police officer in the United States. Officer Overton was sworn in at the Brooklyn Police Department (now part of the New York City Police Department) on March 6, 1891. However, in 2008, a police archivist uncovered information revealing an even earlier “first.” Sergeant Horatio Homer was the first black officer hired by the Boston Police Department on Christmas Eve in 1878. Sergeant Homer went on to serve the department for over four decades.

Today, law enforcement agencies are much more diverse. In fact, many agencies strive for diversity with more and more agencies conducting targeted recruitment campaigns for women and minorities.

Get voice, text and or email notifications when emergencies occur. Access “WebAdvisor” from your college home page. Click “WebAdvisor” from “Login” menu. Click the “Login” link on the Web Advisor home page.

Enter your user ID & password. When you see your name, click “student” or “employee” box on the right.

Note: The box must be colored. Under User Account, click on “My Contact Information.” Enter your address, phone numbers, and type of notification you want to receive: voice only, voice and text, or email. Submit and log off.
