On January 1, 2023, various California laws relative to overall public safety and colleges went into effect. The following are a few of the most relevant laws:

Catalytic Converter Theft - AB 1740 and [SB 1087](#): These laws were enacted to crack down on catalytic converter theft. [AB 1740](#) requires recyclers to include additional information in the written record after receiving a catalytic converter, including the year, make, and model of the vehicle from which the device was removed. A copy of the title of the vehicle from which the catalytic converter was removed must also be provided. SB 1087 prohibits people from buying a used catalytic converter from anyone except certain certified sellers, which includes core recyclers.

Pedestrians Safety - [AB 2147](#): This law prohibits peace officers from stopping pedestrians for certain pedestrian-specific violations, such as crossing the road outside of a crosswalk, unless there is an immediate danger of a crash. The SBCCD PD reminds all road users of the responsibility to travel safely and look out for one another on the road.

Bicycles Omnibus Bill - [AB 1909](#): This law provides for increased protections to bicyclists by requiring vehicles passing or overtaking a bicycle in the same direction, to move over to an adjacent lane of traffic, if one is available, or slow down and only pass the bicyclist when safe to do so.

Affordable Housing - [AB 2011](#) and [SB 6](#): These laws provide avenues to increase the production and affordability housing by turning unused retail properties into housing units. In addition to these two bills, several other bills were signed to fight the state's homeless crisis and develop affordable housing.



Hate Crimes at Schools - [AB 2282](#): This law increases penalties for people who use hateful symbols as part of hate crimes—swastikas, nooses, desecrated crosses - and expands restricted locations to include K-12 schools and colleges. The new law does not criminalize display or placement of the swastika associated with Hinduism, Buddhism and Jainism.

Minimum wage Bump - On January 1, 2023, the minimum wage in California increased to \$15.50 an hour. The minimum wage has been gradually increasing under a 2016 law that brought workers' hourly minimum pay from \$10 to \$15. While larger companies hit the \$15 per hour minimum wage in January 2022, smaller businesses had an

extra year to meet the requirement.

State Holidays - [AB 1655](#) (Juneteenth), [AB 2596](#) (Lunar New Year), and [AB 1801](#) (Genocide Remembrance Day): These bills were enacted to create three new optional California holidays.
