WELCOME TO SPRING SEMESTER 2026

With the start of the Spring semester, the SBCCD Police Department (PD) would like to welcome back students, faculty, and staff. In an effort to assist everyone returning to the campuses, as well as provide them with the basic information needed to properly drive and park on all SBCCD properties, the SBCCD PD wants to advise everyone of the following:

Parking Enforcement - Parking enforcement begins 7:00 am Monday and continues through 4:30 pm Friday. (No permits are required from 4:30 pm Friday through 7:00 am Monday). Grace periods may be implemented at the beginning of each semester for students. **Illegal parking is enforced year around.**

All students, faculty, staff and visitors must register their vehicle license plate when purchasing parking permits. The SBCCD PD will utilize automated license plate readers to verify parking permits are issued to vehicles parked on the campuses. Student, staff and daily parking permits are valid at San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC), Crafton Hills College (CHC), and the District Office. Students and staff may change their permit using a different license plate for the permit if their primary permitted vehicle is unavailable. A valid virtual semester or daily parking permit is required for all vehicles parking on campus (except government vehicles). **Staff permits are required for all staff stalls/lots.** Motorcycles are not required to have a permit, however, motorcycles must be parked in designated motorcycle parking areas.

Daily Parking Permits - Daily parking permits may be purchased on campus for \$3.00 for the entire day. Daily parking permits can also be purchased online by scanning the QR code on the sign in the parking lots or on any of the above websites.

How to Access the Additional Parking:

- Head north on Mt. Vernon Avenue
- Turn right onto Esperanza Street
- Continue to I Street
- Parking is available in the designated shuttle parking lots on I Street

Shuttle Service Information:

- A free shuttle is now running every 15 minutes. From 7:30am-4:00pm Monday-Friday
- The shuttle will take you to and from the shuttle parking lots on I Street and the main campus (Lot 7 & 10).
