- **NEVER** stop at the campus ATM after hours.

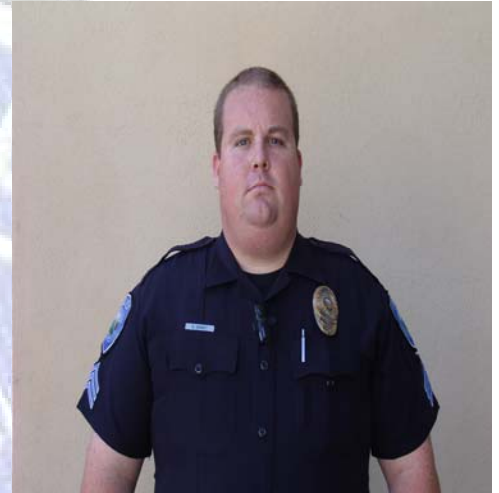
Though it might stir up some nerves just to talk through issues like these, both parents and students will feel more confident with an agreed upon game plan for staying safe.
