School is in Session Drive Safety

School zones are areas marked off near all schools. These areas usually have slower speed limits, especially during school hours. Getting a traffic ticket in a school zone will probably result in a much larger fine. School zone safety laws prevent unnecessary accidents. When school is in session there are kids walking or riding bikes safety tips during school hours:

Seat belts

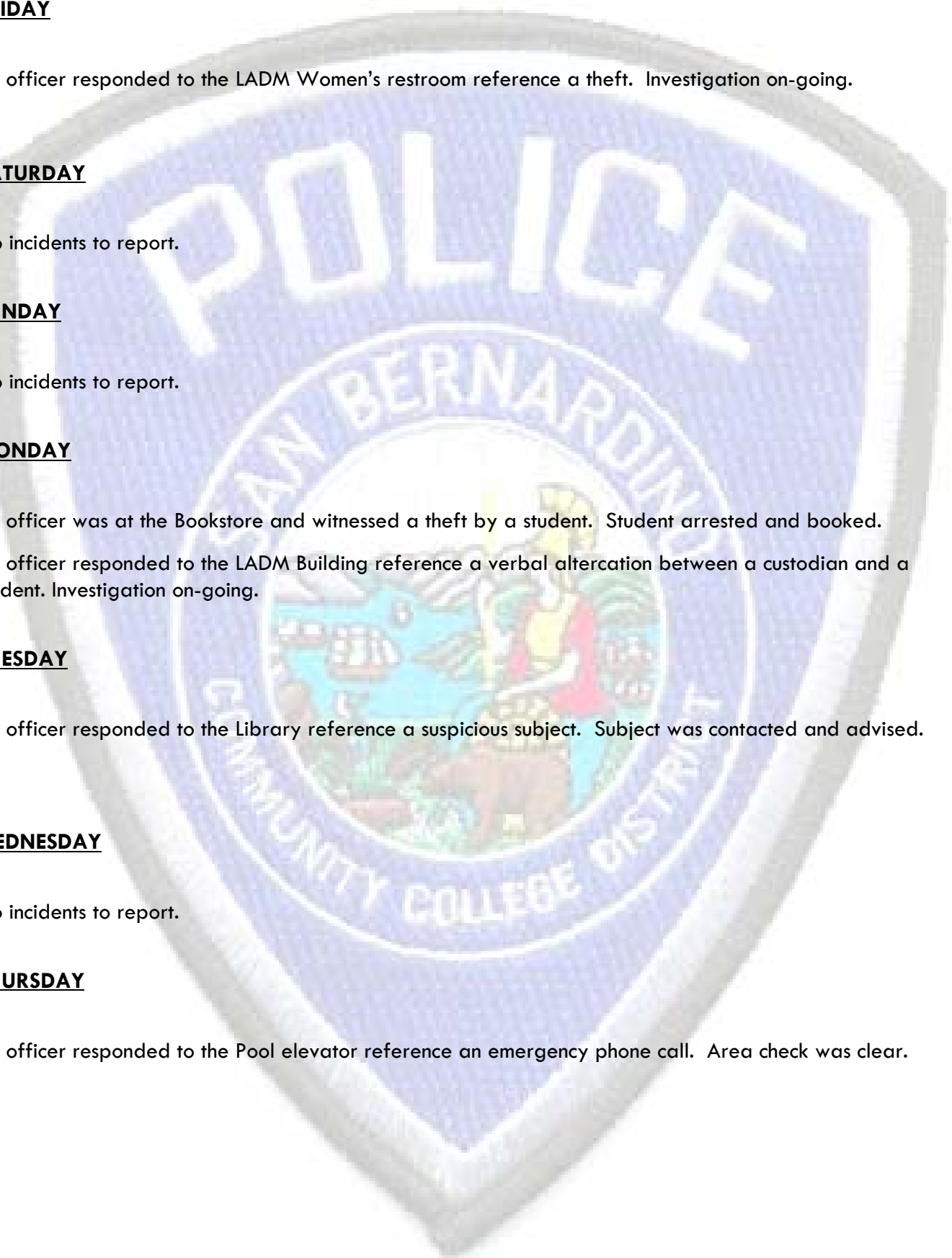

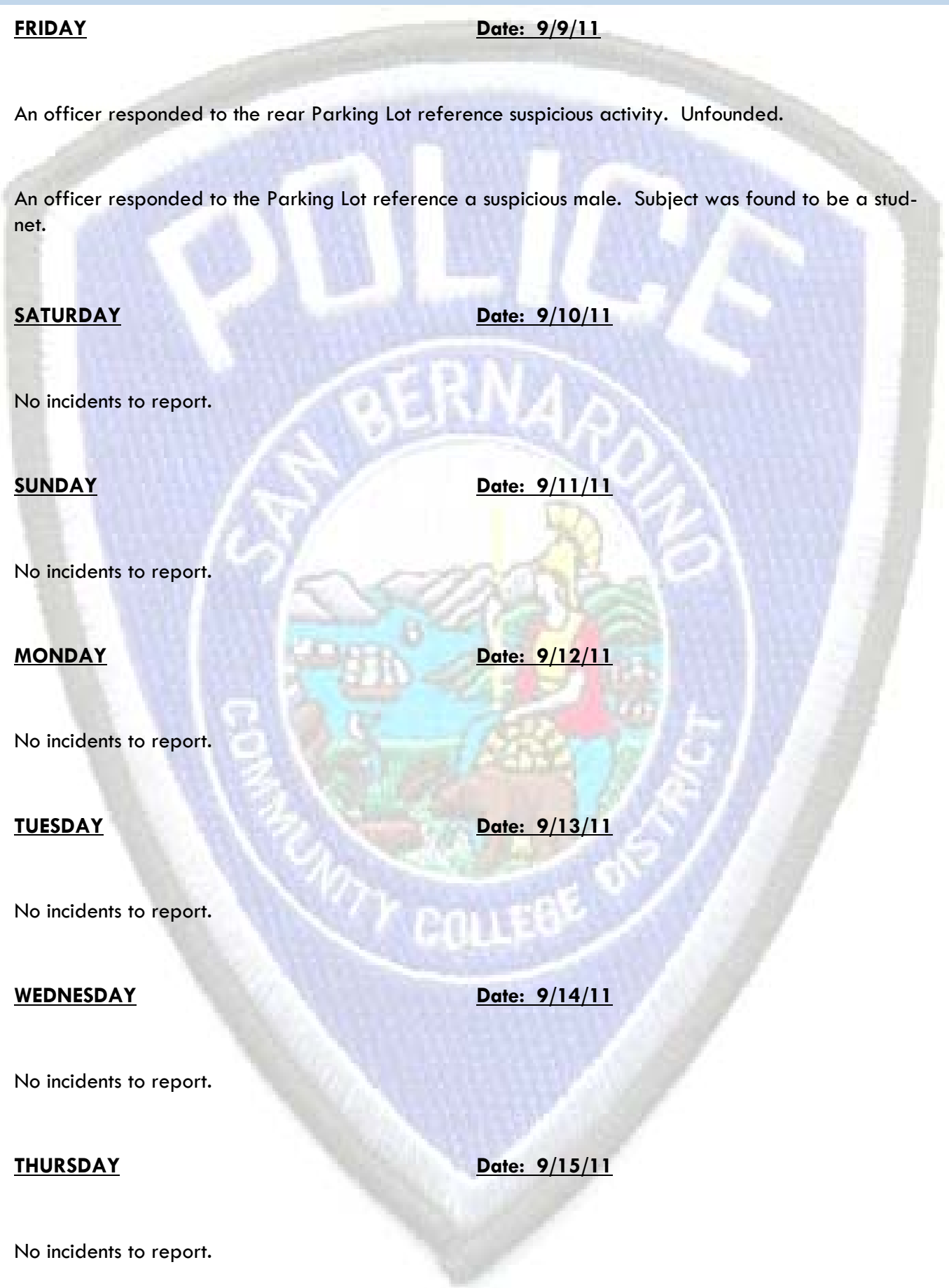
