In 1990, the U.S. Congress enacted the "Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990," which requires colleges and universities to disclose information about crime on and around their campuses. This law was renamed in 1992 to the "Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act". The information in this report is available to all campus community members and the public. This report provides statistical, policy, and procedural information required by law. Del Rosa Drive, San Bernardino, CA 92408 or by calling (909) 382-4000. Through the Outreach and Recruitment Program, all prospective students are provided copies of the Annual Security Report.

The San Bernardino Community College District Police Dept. prepares this report in cooperation with College offices and the police agencies surrounding the main campus of SBCCD and our alternative sites by collecting policy information and crime statistics. All local Police Agencies provide automated statistics for the property and a radius around the property. These statistics may also include crimes that have occurred in private residences or businesses and is not required by law. Student organization recognition does not extend beyond the College and student organizations are not recognized to engage in activity off campus.
