INTERNET SAFETY FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS

Social Networking Websites

Social networking websites connect colleges students with their friends, but these sites are sometimes used by sexual predators to gather information for harassment or by wouldbe fraudsters trying to steal a person's identity.

Considerations

College students also need to keep their computers safe. Because of their need to search the Internet for research, college students will probably run into a website that tries to install malicious or harmful software. While these programs may not physically damage the computer, they often decrease performance.

Potential

Once a person posts something on the Internet it can stay there permanently. A college applicant might ruin their chances at getting accepted if the college admissions officer runs a search on the name and finds inappropriate photos.

Function

Most of the time, college students themselves are responsible for their safety on the Internet because they hold the power to give up their information or accept an installation.

Prevention/Solution

College students should make profiles on social networking sites private and only give information when people really need it. In addition, people should refrain from meeting up in real life with a stranger from the Internet.
