Campus Law Enforcement Policies

San Bernardino Community College District is dedicated to providing a safe, healthy campus environment for students, employees, and the public. The San Bernardino Community College District Police Department (SBCCD Police Department) operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week. A San Bernardino Community College District Police Officer is always on duty to respond to calls for assistance.

The SBCCD Police Department has the authority to enforce the Student Discipline Code of Conduct under the Education Code and the laws of the State of California. San Bernardino Community College District Police personnel are sworn law enforcement officers under 830.32 of the California Penal Code as such they have full arrest authority. This authority extends to anywhere within the state of California. The Department also employs non-sworn Campus Security Officers who serve in a support capacity and do not have the authority to arrest.

The SBCCD Police Department has a strong working relationship with San Bernardino Sheriff's Dept, police department, fire department, parole, probation and paramedics. Persons arrested by officers are transported to the San Bernardino County jail for booking and processing. SBCCD Police Department, pursuant to Section 67380 – 67385.5 of the California Education Code, requires the assistance of the San Bernardino Police Department for Part 1 crimes that occur on campus.

The San Bernardino Community College District Police Department remains the primary law enforcement agency of the SBCCD and will investigate all other crimes occurring on or near the campus community. San Bernardino Community College Police Department, fire department and paramedics can be summoned by calling 911 from a campus phone or 911 from an outside line. Assistance can also be summoned by asking Campus Security Officers to request a Police Officer to respond to your location.
