All buildings are opened by the San Bernardino Community College District Police Department and closed by the custodial dept. We recognize that there will be some need for after-hour and weekend access to buildings. Anyone working late should notify the Police Dept that they will be on campus. Holiday access scheduling is treated as weekend access. Access to the District facilities is limited to staff, students and escorted guest. Entry is monitored on a 24-hour basis. The campus facilities are maintained by Maintenance and Operations and patrolled by San Bernardino Community College District Police Officers. The San Bernardino Community College District Police Officers regularly test the emergency phones and submit work orders for repair, recommend the trimming of shrubbery for safety reasons and conduct periodic lighting surveys. Officers report the need for replacement of lights and any other physical hazards they notice. Lighting and maintenance improvements are constantly being evaluated and are reported to our Maintenance and Operations Dept. Periodic crime prevention surveys are conducted when a crime trend occurs or upon physical changes of office space and equipment when requested by an administrator.
