# ACTIVE SHOOTER WHAT YOU CAN DO

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) announces the availability of a new Independent Study Course titled, Active Shooter, What You Can Do (IS-907). The training is targeted to reach a broad range of individuals, including managers and employees, so they can prepare to respond to an active shooter situation. A active shooter is defined in the course as an individual "engaged in killing or attempting to kill people in a confined and populated area. In most cases, there is no pattern or method to their selection of victims."

The Active Shooter course was developed by the Office of Infrastructure Protection through a collaborative process that included representatives from the Commercial Facilities Sector and FEMA EMI. Development also included consultation with the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center.

The course is self-paced and takes about 45 minutes to complete. Upon completion of Active Shooter, What You Can do, employees and managers will be able to:

- Describe the actions to take when confronted with an active shooter and responding law enforcement officials.
- Recognize potential workplace violence indicators.
- Describe actions to take to prevent and prepare for potential active shooter incidents.
- Describe how to manage the consequences of an active shooter incident.
