ALCOHOL AND DRUGS ON CAMPUS FROM ANNUAL SECURITY REPORT

Alcohol & Drug Policy

The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages and other illegal drugs prior to, or during any College sponsored activity, on or off-campus, by any person attending, regardless of age, is forbidden by State law. The Federal government has mandated that as of October 1, 1990, there will be no drug usage by students, staff, or faculty on college campuses anywhere in the United States. Please see the latest Schedule of Classes for the College's Alcohol and Other Drug Policy.

Alcohol and Other Drugs

San Bernardino Community College District Police Department makes every effort to provide a drug-free campus. Assistance is available for those who seek help for themselves or others who may be addicted to substances. Please contact Student Health Services for confidential services and information. Board Policy 3550 prohibits the possession, use or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol on College property, during any College-sponsored field trips, activities or workshops, by students and employees. (Please refer to that policy for details including sanctions).

Common signs and symptoms of drug abuse

You're neglecting your responsibilities at school, work, or home (e.g. flunking classes, skipping work, neglecting your children) because of your drug use.

You're using drugs under dangerous conditions or taking risks while high, such as driving while on drugs, using dirty needles, or having unprotected sex.

Your drug use is getting you into legal trouble, such as arrests for disorderly conduct, driving under the influence, or stealing to support a drug habit.

Your drug use is causing problems in your relationships, such as fights with your partner or family members, an unhappy boss, or the loss of old friends.

Common signs and symptoms of drug addiction

You've built up a drug tolerance. You need to use more of the drug to experience the same effects you used to attain with smaller amounts.

You take drugs to avoid or relieve withdrawal symptoms. If you go too long without drugs, you experience symptoms such as nausea, restlessness, insomnia, depression, sweating, shaking, and anxiety.

You've lost control over your drug use. You often do drugs or use more than you planned, even though you told yourself you wouldn't. You may want to stop using, but you feel powerless.

Your life revolves around drug use. You spend a lot of time using and thinking about drugs, figuring out how to get them, and recovering from the drug's effects.

You've abandoned activities you used to enjoy, such as hobbies, sports, and socializing, because of your drug use.

You continue to use drugs, despite knowing it's hurting you. It's causing major problems in your life—blackouts, infections, mood swings, depression, paranoia—but you use anyway.

Warning signs that a friend or family member is abusing drugs

Drug abusers often try to conceal their symptoms and downplay their problem. If you're worried that a friend or family member might be abusing drugs, look for the following warning signs:

Physical warning signs of drug abuse

Bloodshot eyes, pupils larger or smaller than usual.

Changes in appetite or sleep patterns. Sudden weight loss or weight gain.

Deterioration of physical appearance, personal grooming habits.

Unusual smells on breath, body, or clothing.

Tremors, slurred speech, or impaired coordination.

Behavioral signs of drug abuse

Drop in attendance and performance at work or school.

Unexplained need for money or financial problems. May borrow or steal to get it.

Engaging in secretive or suspicious behaviors.

Sudden change in friends, favorite hangouts, and hobbies.

Frequently getting into trouble (fights, accidents, illegal activities).

Psychological warning signs of drug abuse

Unexplained change in personality or attitude.

Sudden mood swings, irritability, or angry outbursts.

Periods of unusual hyperactivity, agitation, or giddiness.

Lack of motivation; appears lethargic or "spaced out."

Appears fearful, anxious, or paranoid, with no reason.

Warning signs of teen drug abuse

While experimenting with drugs doesn't automatically lead to drug abuse, early use is a risk factor for developing more serious drug abuse and addiction. Risk of drug abuse also increases greatly during times of transition, such as changing schools, moving, or divorce. The challenge for parents is to distinguish between the normal, often volatile, ups and downs of the teen years and the red flags of substance abuse. These include:

Having bloodshot eyes or dilated pupils; using eye drops to try to mask these signs.

Skipping class; declining grades; suddenly getting into trouble at school.

Missing money, valuables, or prescriptions.

Acting uncharacteristically isolated, withdrawn, angry, or depressed.

Dropping one group of friends for another; being secretive about the new peer group.

Loss of interest in old hobbies; lying about new interests and activities.

Demanding more privacy; locking doors; avoiding eye contact; sneaking around.
