It's Starting To Look A Lot Like Christmas!

Follow these bright tips!

- * First and foremost, check all your equipment. Don't jump on a ladder if it's creaky or too old.
- * Make sure all your lights are working before you get up on the ladder. The less time on a ladder, the better.
- * To avoid blowing the fuses on the line, a good rule of thumb is to make sure your only plugging in three strands end-to-end. If not you may find yourself in the dark.

- * Never decorate the Christmas Tree with lit candles.

- * Make sure your pets stay away from the Christmas Tree. Having animals play around or in the tree can cause the tree to fall over damaging items in the surrounding area.
- * Always watch your children around the Christmas Tree, not only for the lights and electrical cords, but also for glass ordainments that may break if they fall from the tree and land on a hard surface.
- * Remember the holiday season is all about making memories and repeating traditions.
