## Crime Prevention Tips for Athletic Facilities

Campus safety is everybody's business. Campus Safety Officers cannot be everywhere at once, consequently, they depend on you to recognize and report suspicious and criminal activities. The extent of your cooperation greatly influences the Campus Safety Officers' effectiveness in combating crime.

### Doing Your Part

- ${\it l.}$  Avoid using athletic facilities alone, especially after dark or during off-hours.
- 2. Use the "buddy system." Workout with a friend, and make arrangements to leave the facilities together.
- Confine your running and jogging to the daylight hours and to open well-traveled areas. If you run or jog at night you should wear a reflective vest.
- 4. Avoid showering alone in the locker room.
- 5. In the locker rooms:
- A. Become familiar with the location of facility phones.
- B. If there is another person in the locker room, ask for them to wait for you.
- C. If you encounter an intruder in the locker room:
- Call for help.
- Keep out of the intruder's way; do not attempt to detain.
- Formulate a description of the intruder in your mind.
- Notify the Campus Police Department by dialing 909-384-4491 or extension 4491 on a campus phone.
