March Is Women's History Month

Law enforcement agencies had employed women since 1891 but solely to care for female prisoners. In 1909, social worker Alice Stebbins Wells petitioned Mayor George Alexander and the Los Angeles City Council requesting an ordinance to better aid other women and children who were victims of crime. In September 1910, the measure was passed and Alice Wells was appointed as the nation's first female policewoman with arrest powers.

Wells was hired and equipped with a telephone call box, a police rule book and first aid book, and the Policewoman's Badge Number One.







She was made responsible to hand sew her own police uniform, which was the first woman's uniform in the US. She was assigned to work with the LAPD's first juvenile officer, and was quickly the subject of an order issued by the force that ruled: "No young girl can be questioned by a male officer. Such work is delegated solely to policewomen, who, by their womanly sympathy and intuition, are able to gain the confidence of their younger sisters."

Her first duties included supervision and enforcement of laws concerning "dance halls, skating rinks, penny arcades, picture shows, and other similar places of public recreation." Among her activities was the "suppression of unwholesome billboard displays, searches for missing persons, and the maintenance of a general information bureau for women seeking advice on matters within the scope of police departments."

Alice Wells also founded the International Policewomen's Association in 1915 that led other countries to follow suit and hire female police officers. Three years later, she succeeded in persuading the University of California, Southern Division (now UCLA) to offer the first course specifically on the work of women police officers. The course was introduced by the school's Criminology Department in the summer session in 1918.
