### Mental Illness on Campus

Times of anxiety and feeling down are common experiences in college, but did you know that they may be part of a treatable mental health condition? The latest research reports that feeling depressed to the point where students have trouble functioning impacts about 40% of students. Further, research indicates about 15% of college students have serious clinical depression. Additionally, about 1,100 college students commit suicide annually; which is a preventable catastrophe. Moreover:

- ⇒ 75% of lifetime cases of mental health conditions begin by age 24.
- ⇒ One in four young adults between the ages of 18 and 24 have diagnosable mental illness. More than 25% of college students have been diagnosed or treated by a professional for a mental health condition within the past year.
- ⇒ More than 11% of college students have been diagnosed or treated for anxiety in the past year and more than 10% reported being diagnosed or treated for depression.
- ⇒ More than 40% of college students have felt more than an average amount of stress within the past 12 months.
- ⇒ Almost 73% of students living with a mental health condition experienced a mental health crisis on campus.
