Your Basics Rights and Responsibilities:

Your basic rights and responsibilities may not always be clearly defined by law enforcement. The first words spoken by either the officer or the citizen involved may very well determine the tone of the encounter and even the eventual outcome.

If you are stopped on the street:

- \Rightarrow Answer all questions pertaining to your identity.
- ⇒ Remember, you are not required to give testimony against yourself. (you have the right to remain silent)
- \Rightarrow Do not "bad mouth" or walk away from law enforcement officials.
- ⇒ If an officer has a "reasonable suspicion" that you will be carrying a weapon or illegal substance, you may be subject to a "pat-down" search. Do not resist the search.

If you are stopped in a car:

- \Rightarrow Slow down; safely pull over as soon as you can.
- \Rightarrow Stay in the driver's seat with both hands in sight on the steering wheel. **Do not exit the car unless asked to do so.**
- ⇒ If the officer believes a crime has been committed, your car may be searched without a court-issued warrant.
- \Rightarrow If you are issued a ticket, sign it. (Doing so is not an admission of guilt)

Officer Conduct and Your Response

The best way to avoid conflict is to not provoke the officer while having a discussion about law enforcement matters.

- ♦ Do not resist arrest for any reason.
- ♦ Control your emotions.
- ◊ Do not make threatening motions or statements to the officers talking to you.
- \diamond ~ Never attempt to interfere with the arrest of others who may be with you.
- \diamond Always note the name of the officers with whom you come in contact.
- ◊ Record, document and report officer misconduct immediately.
