## 7 Ways to Avoid Package Theft During the Holidays

Want to avoid these crimes of opportunity? Here are a few tips to keep your packages safe during the holidays:

1. Ask for a tracking number to know when your package is delivered. Track your package and try to be home at the time of delivery. When you're placing an order, try to schedule the shipment for a day you expect to be home, if possible.
2. Not sure if you'll be available for your tracked package's delivery? FedEx and USPS suggest scheduling your delivery beforehand to set a time you know you'll be home.
3. FedEx also suggest requesting a signature for delivery. This will ensure the package won't be left at your door without you there to sign and bring it safely inside.
4. Want your package placed at the back door or behind a porch plant instead? Leave a note specifying what less conspicuous spot you would like it left.
5. Have your packages delivered somewhere else. If you know you won't be home when your package will be delivered, FedEx and UPS tell you to opt for delivering it to a neighbor who is home or to your workplace.
6. Another option is to deliver your packages to a retail store or locker, where they'll stay safe until you can pick them up at your convenience. Many retailers will let you place online orders and then pick up your items in the store.
