## ANNUAL SECURITY REPORT

The San Bernardino Community College District (SBCCD), in compliance with requirements of the Jeanne Clery Act, has produced their 2020 Annual Security Report (ASR), which is now available online at [sbccd.edu/asr](http://sbccd.edu/asr). The ASR provides the crime statistics for Crafton Hills College (CHC), San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC), as well as District Support Operations (DSO). The report was prepared by the SBCCD Police Department (PD) management team, in cooperation with several college offices and surrounding police agencies. Federal law directs all institutions of higher education to publish an ASR by October 1st of each year.

In order to provide additional access to the report, a printed copy of the ASR can be obtained from the SBCCD PD, SBCCD Office, and at various locations on the CHC and SBVC campuses.

## Breast Cancer Awareness Month

October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month. This year it's estimated that approximately 276,480 women within the United States will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer, with 48,530 new cases of non-invasive breast cancer. Excluding cancers of the skin, breast cancer is the most frequently diagnosed cancer in women. It is the second leading cause of cancer death in American women after lung cancer. The chance that a woman will die from breast cancer is about 1 in 38 (about 2.6%).

According to the American Cancer Society, since 2007 breast cancer death rates have been steady in women younger than 50 but have continued to decrease in older women. From 2013 to 2017, the death rate decreased by 1.3% per year. These decreases are believed to be the result of finding breast cancer earlier through screening and increased awareness, as well as better treatments.

At this time, there are more than 3.5 million breast cancer survivors in the United States. This includes women still being treated and those who have completed treatment. Additionally, the American Cancer Society reports:

- About 1 in 8 U.S. women (about 12%) will develop invasive breast cancer over the course of their lifetime.
- As of January 2020, there were more than 3.5 million women with a history of breast cancer in the U.S.
- About 42,170 women will die from breast cancer.

For now, the best way to find breast cancer early is for women to get regular mammograms and continue to do so as long as they are in good health. The American Cancer Society recommends the following:

- Women between the ages of 40 and 44 have the option to start screening with a mammogram every year. Women between 45 to 54 should get mammograms every year.
- Women 55 and older should switch to mammograms every 2 years or continue yearly screening.
- Screening should continue as long as a woman is in good health and is expected to live at least 10 more years.

In addition, women can take the following steps to help lower their risk of breast cancer:

- Get to and stay at a healthy weight.
- Follow a healthy eating pattern.
- Stay active and avoid time spent sitting.
- Limit alcohol consumption to no more than one drink a day.
