4 **PROBATION, DISMISSAL AND READMISSION**

5  
6 **A. Academic Probation**

7  
8 After earning twelve or more units at a District college, a student shall be placed on  
9 academic probation when his/her grade point average falls below 2.0 for all work attempted.

10  
11 **B. Progress Probation**

12  
13 After earning twelve or more units at a District college, a student shall be placed on progress  
14 probation when the percentage of all units in which the student has enrolled for which entries  
15 of W, I, NC and NP were recorded reaches or exceed fifty percent.

16  
17 **D. Appeal/Removal from Probationary Status**

- 18  
19 1. A student may appeal probationary status by filing a request for special  
20 consideration with the designated academic standards committee at each college.  
21  
22 2. A student who has been placed on academic probation shall revert to good standing  
23 upon attaining a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher for all units  
24 attempted. All units attempted are defined as all units of credit for which the student  
25 is enrolled in at the community college that he/she attends.  
26  
27 3. A student who has been placed on progress probation shall revert to good standing  
28 when the percentage of all units in which the student has enrolled for which entries  
29 of W, I, NC and NP were recorded falls below fifty percent.  
30

31 **E. Intervention**

32  
33 A student who continues to maintain a grade point average below 2.0 while on academic or  
34 progress probation will not be allowed to register for succeeding terms until that student has  
35 completed the requirements established by the Counseling department at the college he/she  
36 attends.  
37

38 **F. Dismissal/Readmission Standards**

39  
40 For the purposes of this section, semesters shall be considered consecutive on the basis of  
41 the student's enrollment, i.e., Fall enrollment to Fall enrollment shall be considered  
42 consecutive if the student did not enroll in the intervening Spring semester.  
43

44 **G. Dismissal**

45  
46 A student on academic and/or progress probation shall be dismissed for one semester when  
47 one or more of the following conditions exist:  
48

- 49 1. The student has earned a cumulative grade point average of less than 2.0 in all  
50 units attempted in each of three consecutive semesters.  
51  
52 2. The student has received a W, I, NC, or NP in fifty percent or more of the units for  
53 which he/she was enrolled in each of three consecutive semesters.  
54

55 **H. Readmission**

- 56  
57 1. A student may appeal dismissal by filing a request as a part of the procedures  
58 established at the college he/she attends.  
59

- 60 2. A student may be reinstated after one semester from the date of dismissal.  
61  
62 3. A student enrolled following dismissal shall be on probationary status and subject to  
63 dismissal.  
64  
65 4. If the scholastic achievement of a student readmitted after dismissal continues at a  
66 probationary level, the student may be dismissed for one year.
