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4 **STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES**
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6 **A.** Each college shall provide an office of health services for students. Students shall pay fees
7 for health and accident insurance coverage that shall be used solely to defray the costs of
8 such health services and accident coverage as provided in the Education Code. Fees shall
9 be specified in Board Policy.

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11 **B.** Exemptions

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13 Certain individuals designated herein shall be exempt from health and accident fees by code
14 exemption or action of the Board of Trustees.

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16 1. Apprentices attending college under an approved training program.
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18 2. Students who depend exclusively upon prayer for healing in accordance with the
19 teaching of a bona fide religious sect, denomination or organization.
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21 3. Students who submit evidence that they are financially unable to pay the fee
22 because of low income. The health fee for these students may be included as part
23 of the financial aid package for students who receive government grants.
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25 4. Students enrolled only in Community Services Classes.
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27 5. Students enrolled in off-campus classes that are conducted entirely at the agency
28 site.

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30 **C.** Students who are enrolled exclusively in IBS classes shall pay only the accident insurance
31 fee.

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33 **D.** Students who do not pay health or accident insurance fees are not eligible for health
34 services.

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36 **E.** International Students must purchase a Student Accident and Sickness Medical Expense
37 Plan or show evidence of equal coverage and provide a negative tuberculosis skin test or a
38 chest x-ray performed in the United States.
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
