ADVISORY VOTING STUDENT MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

In compliance with Education Code Section 72023.5, the Board of Trustees of the San

Bernardino Community College District may include two advisory voting student members who

witnesses and the discussion of issues, with the following exceptions:

1. The student member shall not have the right or be afforded the opportunity to either

- by Education Code Section 72425. In the event a student Board member has an unexcused absence to a required meeting, the compensation shall be pro rated for the pay period.
- 3. The student member shall not be entitled to vote on matters being considered by the Board of Trustees except in an advisory capacity that will not be tallied into the official vote.

The term of the student member shall be one year, commencing on, May 15 each fiscal year. The student will be seated at the next regular Board meeting following the beginning of their one-year term of office.

The student Board member shall meet the eligibility requirements as outlined in Board Policy 2060.
