4 **DRUG FREE ENVIRONMENT AND DRUG PREVENTION PROGRAM**
5

6 The District shall be free from all drugs and from the unlawful possession, use or distribution of
7 illicit drugs and alcohol by students and employees.

8
9 The unlawful manufacturing, distribution, dispensing, possession or use of a controlled substance
10 is prohibited in all facilities under the control and use of the District.

11
12 Any student or employee who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action, (consistent
13 with local, state, or federal law), which may include referral to an appropriate rehabilitation
14 program, suspension, demotion, expulsion or dismissal.

15
16 The Chancellor shall assure that the District distributes annually to each student and employee
17 the information required by the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989
18 and complies with other requirements of the Act.
