4 **PROBATION, DISMISSAL AND READMISSION**

6 **Probation**

7 A student shall be placed on academic probation if he or she has attempted a minimum of 12
8 semester units of work and has a grade point average of less than a C (2.0).

9 A student shall be placed on progress probation if he or she has enrolled in a total of at least 12
10 semester units and the percentage of all units in which the student has enrolled, for which entries
11 of W, I, NC, and NP were recorded reaches or exceeds fifty percent.

12 A student who is placed on probation may submit an appeal in accordance with regulations to be
13 established by the Chancellor.

14 A student on academic probation shall be removed from probation when the student's
15 accumulated grade point average is 2.0 or higher. A student on progress probation shall be
16 removed from probation when the percentage of units in the categories of W, I, NC, and NP drops
17 below fifty percent.

18 **Dismissal**

19 A student who is on academic probation shall be subject to dismissal if the student has earned a
20 cumulative grade point average of less than 2.00 in all units attempted in each of three (3)
21 consecutive semesters.

22 A student who is on progress probation shall be subject to dismissal if the cumulative percentage
23 of units in which the student has been enrolled for which entries of W, I, NC and NP are recorded
24 in at least three (3) consecutive semesters reaches or exceeds fifty percent.

25 A student who is subject to dismissal may submit a written appeal in compliance with
26 administrative regulations.

27 **Readmission**

28 A student who has been dismissed may request reinstatement. Readmission may be granted,
29 denied or postponed according to criteria contained in administrative regulations.

30 The Chancellor shall develop procedures for the implementation of this policy that comply with
31 the Title 5 requirements.
