4 ADMISSIONS 5

The District shall admit students who meet one of the following requirements:

- Any individual who has graduated from high school or who has been awarded a California Certificate of Proficiency or who has successfully completed the GED.
- Persons who are 18 years of age or above and who, in the judgment of the Chancellor or his or her designee are capable of profiting from the instruction offered. Such persons shall be admitted as provisional students, and thereafter shall be required to comply with the District's rules and regulations regarding scholastic achievement and other standards to be met by provisional or probationary students as a condition to being readmitted in any succeeding semester.
- Persons who are apprentices as defined in Section 3077 of the Labor Code.
- Any pupil enrolled in grades K-12 from a public school district in accordance with state laws governing concurrent enrollment and BP6020.
