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4 **SPEECH: TIME, PLACE, AND MANNER**
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6 The colleges of the District are non-public forums, except for those areas designated as Free
7 Speech Areas, which are limited public forums. The Chancellor shall enact such administrative
8 regulations as are necessary to reasonably regulate the time, place and manner of the exercise
9 of free expression in the limited public forums.

10 The administrative procedures promulgated by the Chancellor shall not prohibit the right of any
11 person to exercise free expression, including but not limited to the distribution of printed materials
12 or petitions in those parts of the college designated as Free Speech areas, and the wearing of
13 buttons, badges, or other insignia.

14 Students, District employees and members of the public shall be free to exercise their rights of
15 free expression, subject to the requirements of this policy.

16 Speech shall be prohibited that is defamatory, obscene according to current legal standards, or
17 which so incites others as to create a clear and present danger of the commission of unlawful
18 acts on district property or the violation of district policies or procedures, or the substantial
19 disruption of the orderly operation of the District.

20 Nothing in this policy shall prohibit the regulation of hate violence, so long as the regulation
21 conforms to the requirements of the First Amendment to the United States Constitution, and of
22 Section 2 of Article 1 of the California Constitution. Students may be disciplined for harassment,
23 threats, intimidation, or hate violence unless such speech is constitutionally protected.
