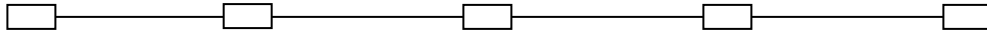

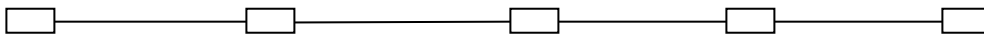

SBVC has 3 high fidelity simulators that are not being used to their capacity and we need to incorporate more simulation into our curriculum. We are lacking a Simulation Tech and space is limited in the Skills Lab to accomplish a complete nursing simulation scenario. We are working on attaining the adequate space and Simulation Tech for this to be integrated into our program.
