Replacement X Growth

1. Renovation Request

When the auditorium was renovated, the dance studio was “cost engineered” out of the space, with the program being given assurances that there was a space in the new PE facility. Since that time, communication was not clear with the PE staff. As a result, conflict has arisen regarding space for the dance program. This is a popular program that needs to be provided a space for appropriate classes to be held in a safe facility. Additionally, the Theatre Arts program requires occasional rehearsal space in a dance studio. The programs understand the need for sharing space and do not need or request a full-time facility. However, it must be provided opportunity to hold classes at other than 8:00 AM as is currently available to them within the existing PE facility. The dance studio must have appropriate flooring to support jumps and leaps, mirrors, sound system and barres. We are requesting reasonable use of an appropriate space within the new Physical Education facility. We have been in ongoing negotiations/meeting with the PE department and in touch with the President as well as both Deans in the related divisions. In order for the dance and theatre programs to thrive, they require a safe reliable dance floor, mirrors, barres and sound equipment for multiple dance styles including ballet (we’ve had to eliminate these classes due to lack of space), jazz and modern dance programs and for occasional use by the theatre arts performance courses for such programs as musical theatre and stage movement.
