1. Provide a rationale for your request. (Explain, in detail, the need for this project.)

To change the nursing computer lab to HLS 131 so that we can have 50 computers instead of 40 in the current nursing computer lab. We would switch the skills lab in HLS 131 with the present computer lab in HLS 130. Most nursing examinations are now given electronically and with the Enrollment and Growth Grant we are allowing more students into the nursing program. The Grant has also afforded the nursing program end of course HESI examinations and some classes have more than 40 students. It is difficult to plan examinations when the nursing computer lab is open with the computer lab located in HLS 231. We admit students twice a year and they are invited to take the Admission HESI exam prior to be accepted into the program. We are only able to invite 40 students to take this exam at one time due to the number of computers we now have available. We are in desperate need to increase the number of computers available in the computer lab to accompany our growing needs.
