The College has established Institutional Set Standards for various measures for assessing student success. These standards represent the floor for their respective data elements. A **six-year average** is analyzed and the set standard is established through a collaborative process through the College's participatory governance structure.

LEVEL	DEFINITION	ACTIONS
FLOOR	More than One (1) Standard Deviation Below the Three (3) Year Average	Triggers Investigation <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Outside Factors• Interventions
GOAL	Equal to One (1) Standard Deviation Above the Three (3) Year Average	Monitor
STRETCH GOAL	Greater than or Equal to One and One Half (1.5) Standard Deviation Above the Three (3) Year Average	Triggers Analysis <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sustainable?• Replicable?
