SLO & Progra Reporting	P. Ferri-Milligan opened at 9:00 a.m. with introduction of Celia Huston for discussion of SLOs/PLOs as related to the Program Review Process. Academic Senate made a motion to align SLOs/PLOs w/Program Review. Currently, SLOs/PLOs are on a three-year cycle, and Program Review is on a four-year cycle, so the cycles need to be coordinated. Proposal is to change SLO/PLO cycle to four-year cycle. For courses, it is easy to run export and see assessment. Working with Jason Brady at District and some tracking is still in paper form. Upload to Cloud will allow storage online and will generate spreadsheet of each course and the last time each was reported. Will show last time done and next time due; it is understood that it will be due every four years. Helps rotation tracking for department heads and managers and eliminates having to write summaries and produce hardbound reports. ACCJC wants us to demonstrate how SLOs are tied to Program Review/development and description of resources, so ties to needs assessment and shows all ties required. Would want something along the lines of how are you using to improve teaching and learning. No need to report for every single course, but selected courses, so not as exhaustive with reporting on all.  Motion by Paula Ferri-Milligan to officially accept housing of SLO/PLO process in Program Review, which will convert SLO/PLO process to four-year cycle from three-year cycle.
