Thank you for your email. I hope that you and your family are safe and well. Concerning your inquiry, the Writing Center assesses SAOs every semester. We have regularly maintained a high level of student satisfaction based on the data collected from the surveys. However, in terms of responding to student needs and improving our services, in our surveys, we have a qualitative component in which students can provide feedback in the form of comments. In the past, one request that was brought up a number of times was the need for more drop-in spots. As a center, we worked it out so that drop-in spots were more strategically placed throughout the tutors' schedules, thus accommodating for more students who did not have appointments. We have had fewer requests for drop-in spots as a result of this response.

This is just one instance of how the Writing Center has used SAO data and other measures to improve services.
