

Admissions and Records will be distributing diplomas on July 20th and July 21st from Da.m. to 2 p.m. Graduates must have a photo ID to pick up diplomas.

Please remain in your vehicle during the time you are on campus to pick up your graduation depsakes to limit contact between you and others. Staff will be wearing masks and dobves while handing you your cap, tassel and degree frame.

Curbside Pick-Up Instructions: Using Esperanza Street, entering Parking Lot 4 as noted by the bright yellow star on this map. Admissions and Records staff will guide yout dwards Parking Lot 3 (light blue arrows) where two lines of cars will form. Staff will be at two kiosks handing out diplomas.

You must wear and mask and remain in your vehicles.

Exit out of Parking Lot 3 and turn right in front of the Auditorium. You will exit campus between Lots 1 and 2 and safely turn right onto Mt. Vernon. See map below for details.


