Submit a Work Request

Work requests are typically performed on a first-come first-served basis for routine repairs and/or maintenance. If you have a maintenance concern that is of an emergency nature, please contact the Maintenance Department at (909)384-8906 during normal business hours. After hours emergencies should be reported to the SBCCD Police at (909)384-4491.

Reasons to process work requests:

- Plumbing problems (leaks, clogged/broken toilets, sinks and drains)
- Electrical problems (lights out, no power to outlets)
- Heating or Cooling issues (too hot/cold, no air flow)
- Smoke detectors buzzing or alarm panels beeping
- Key/lock/door issues (new or replacement keys, locks not functioning, doors slamming)
- Unsafe conditions (windows/doors that don't lock, trip hazards)
