4 **CIVIC CENTER AND OTHER FACILITIES USE**

6 There is a Civic Center at each of the colleges and Centers. Use of the Civic Center shall be
7 granted as provided by law. The Chancellor shall establish procedures regarding the use of
8 college property, including but not limited to facilities, equipment and supplies, by community
9 groups and other outside contractors.

10 These administrative procedures shall reflect the requirements of applicable law, including
11 Education Code Section 82537, regarding Civic Centers. The regulations shall include
12 reasonable rules regarding the time, place and manner of use of District facilities. They shall
13 assure that persons or organizations using college property are charged such fees as are
14 authorized by law. Public use of District property shall not interfere with scheduled instructional
15 programs or other activities.

16 No group or organization may use District property for purposes that discriminate on the basis of
17 race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, disability, sex (i.e., gender), or sexual orientation, or
18 the perception that a person has one or more of the foregoing characteristics.
