VII. SUMMARY

The San Bernardino Community College District serves many cities in the inland Southern California area and serves an additional 27,000 students each year at Crafton Hills College and San Bernardino Valley College. The District has recently purchased two new buildings: the new District Office building and 1818 E Highland Avenue. The new District Office building now houses the Technology & Educational Support Services and the District is no longer leasing the property for this location. The 1818 Highland Avenue and San Bernardino CCD Annex locations are not currently being rented or occupied. The old District Office location still houses a few departments for San Bernardino Community College and the Professional Development Center (PDC); however, many of the departments have moved to the new District Office location. The Alternate Text Production Center still is a leased property in Camarillo.

The District will be receiving additional funding through Measure CC that was passed in 2018. This Measure will allow the continued renovation of the different structures throughout both Crafton Hills College and San Bernardino Valley College.

The SWACC Property & Liability (P&L) inspection is intended to help streamline the process for identifying and mitigating targeted P&L exposures. This report contains a loss experience review, a program review, and site-specific findings and recommendations.

VIII. LOSS EXPERIENCE REVIEW

San Bernardino Community College District has had five property losses since the 2017 policy year for a total incurred of \$158,102.60. There were three claims of equipment failure for a total incurred of \$94,424.90, one claim for a stolen transit van for a total incurred of \$8,677.70, and one claim of vandalism for a total incurred of \$55,000.00.

On the liability side, there have been nine claims filed since the beginning of the 2017 policy year with a total incurred of \$359,168.17. There were three employment practice liability claims for a total incurred of \$163,653.71; two auto liability claims for a total incurred of \$13,318.55; one claim of cyber security for a total incurred of \$25,000.00; one claim where the school's security officer lost claimant's California Identification card while on campus for a total incurred of zero loss; one claim where a contractor alleges the District breached the contract, resulting in substantial damages for a total incurred of zero loss and one claim of a claimant who was pulling a pool tarp when it snapped causing him to fall and hit his head for a total incurred of \$157,195.91.

IX. PROGRAM REVIEW

Security/Theft/Vandalism	
Priority: EFFECTIVE	
Survey Findings:	
Police officers on college campuses are POST trained (SB 1626). They utilize security for off hours. There are intrusion alarms throughout the sites that are monitored by an outside agency. There is video surveillance system implemented at the college; however, it could improve in certain spots. At the time of the inspection, the new vacant location on 1818 Highland Ave. had been vandalized with trash in the parking lot and a broken window. This location should be considered for video surveillance. They have adequate lighting at the campuses in the evening. The valuables and laptops are adequately secured. The college does not utilize an anonymous reporting system for high frequency loss areas/sites.	
Corrective Action:	
The college should consider additional video surveillance in areas that are secluded and are prone to vandalism and theft. The college should utilize an anonymous reporting system for high frequency loss areas/sites.	
Emergency Preparedness	
Priority: EFFECTIVE	
Survey Findings:	
According to the college, there is an Emergency Operations Plan for all campuses that is being revised and evaluated. The EOP was just recently updated. The District conducts regular mock drills both fire and earthquakes. Emergency supplies are available at each site and checking/replacement is done by each department. They have the local police, fire, and County EMS involved in their Emergency Preparedness Programs.	
Corrective Action:	
None at this time.	
Fire/Arson Prevention	
Priority: EFFECTIVE	
Survey Findings:	
Kitchen hoods, fire extinguishers, and sprinkler systems are serviced at the required intervals. The fire extinguishers are inspected monthly and initialed on the tag depending on the department. At the time of the inspection, the fire extinguishers at many of the locations were missing the monthly inspections. The fire alarms are tested. The trash cans are emptied regularly to keep from overflowing and stored away from structures. Combustible materials are stored away from public access.	
Corrective Action:	
The campuses should be inspecting the fire extinguishers on a monthly basis and initialing the tag.	
Utility Cart	
Priority: EFFECTIVE	
Survey Findings:	

There is no key control program in place. All utility carts require a key to operate and there is a utility cart plan/policy. The operators have been provided safety training. They do inspect and do maintenance on the utility carts.

Corrective Action:

A key control program should be implemented and more regular inspections/maintenance should be conducted on the utility carts.

Playground Safety

Priority: INEFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

Playground supervisors are trained annually regarding their duties. The college does not have a formal, documented system for inspecting the playground equipment and surfacing. There is a budget/plan in place to replace old/deteriorating playground equipment or surfacing material.

Corrective Action:

The college should have a formal, documented system for inspecting play equipment and surfacing. There are a few safety issues that are noted in the report with regards to the playground safety.

Chemical Safety

Priority: EFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

The college does have a policy on employees bringing chemicals/cleaners from sources outside the college. The college is in the process of maintaining and regularly testing the eyewash/deluge. All students are to wear PPE while conducting science experiments. All hazardous materials are stored in a way to prevent unauthorized access.

Corrective Action:

Make sure that all eyewash stations are inspected and tested monthly to ensure that they are clean, accessible, and operational.

Self-Inspection Program

Priority: INEFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

There is a self-inspection system in place based on the IIPP but the college is unsure if it meets the JPA's requirements. The site supervisors/administrators do not review their site self-inspections. The self-inspections have not been documented.

Corrective Action:

There should be a formal/documented self-inspection system in place and the site supervisors/administrators should review the findings.

EPL

Priority: EFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

There is effective communication between site management and Human Resources prior to any significant employment action decisions taking place. Investigation procedures and documentation are in place for employee/employment complaints. Training has been provided and documentation maintained for supervisors on employment/management/supervisory related topics.

Corrective Action:

None at this time.

Abuse Prevention

Priority: EFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

The college has a Title IX Coordinator. There is education on bullying awareness and reporting. The District utilizes an anonymous reporting hotline. Staff have been trained on recognition of abuse/mandated reporting. A staff social media policy is in place for the use of technology/internet/ social media with students under AP 3720. The staff are not prohibited from having one-on-one student meetings in closed rooms. They are not prohibited from leaving students unsupervised. There is staff training on appropriate staff/student boundaries. The windows on offices and classrooms are for the most part required to be uncovered. During the inspection, it was common to see office windows to be covered with paper.

Corrective Action:

Consider creating more visibility into offices by removing any paper on windows and ensure that window blinds are open during campus hours. Staff should be prohibited from having one-on-one staff-student meetings in closed rooms, especially with students who are minors. Staff should be prohibited from leaving students unsupervised.

Student Transportation

Priority: EFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

The College does provide driver training. They actively monitor the DMV pull program for everyone driving on District business. There is a key control program and a driver's policy in place. Depending on the department if the vehicles are inspected prior to each use and if there is an accident reporting tool kits in vehicles.

Corrective Action:

The College should ensure that each vehicle is inspected prior to use and has an accident reporting kit.

Water Losses

Priority: INEFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

There are currently some documented preventative maintenance programs in place for vegetation, roofs, drains, and plumbing. The college does conduct pre and post storm inspections tied to weather forecasts. The gutters/drains are inspected but not on a regular basis. They have quick response resources in place for water related damage. They do not have loss/damage prevention procedures in place to address weather related freezing conditions.

Corrective Action:

There should be a formalized documented preventative maintenance program in place for vegetation, roofs, drains and plumbing at both campuses. The gutters and drains should be inspected on a more regular basis. There should be loss/damage prevention procedures in place to address weather related freezing conditions.

Lockdown Procedures/Door Lock Devices

Priority: EFFECTIVE

Survey Findings:

The college does not conduct/document lock-down drills. The classrooms doors have the ability to be locked from the inside without the use of a key. It is up to the instructor's discretion if the doors are kept closed and locked during normal/full class sessions. The exterior facing windows can be adequately obscured during a lock-down; however, the windows within the buildings cannot.

Corrective Action:

There should be documented lock-down drills conducted. The windows within the buildings should have the capability to be obscured during a lock-down.

I . RISK TRANSFER PROCEDURES

Consider reviewing the District's risk transfer procedures and facility use agreements. Keenan's risk transfer forms, such as templates for field trips, facilities use agreements, and contractor agreements can be located on the P&C Bridge under RisKAdvisor. The risk transfer forms can be used as is or can be modified to support the District's current procedures and policies.

I I. RECOMMENDATIONS

Recommendations resulting from the inspection are listed under Site Specific or General findings. Site Specific recommendations are those that are specific in nature and pertain only to a particular site. General recommendations are those that apply to some or all sites or operations throughout the District.

Each recommendation is categorized as either Immediate, High, Medium or Low. **Immediate** is a hazard the represents a significant life-threatening danger requiring immediate attention. **High** is an exposure that, if not corrected, has the potential to result in a severe property or liability loss in the short term. **Medium** is an exposure that, while having the potential for a loss, would not normally result in a significant or severe loss. **Low** is an exposure that is commonplace throughout the District.

Immediate/High priority items are listed separately due to the severity of the exposure.
