## CITIZENS BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE (CBOC)

### PROPOSITION 39 BOND ELECTION

On November 6, 2018, voters residing within the San Bernardino Community College District passed Measure CC. Measure CC is a \$470 million bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to college facilities located within the District. ### COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES

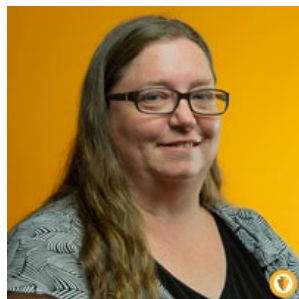

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Proposition M and Measure CC bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Proposition M and Measure CC bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Proposition M and Measure CC; and
- Present to the Board in public session, an annual written report outlining the Committee's activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Proposition M and Measure CC bond proceeds.

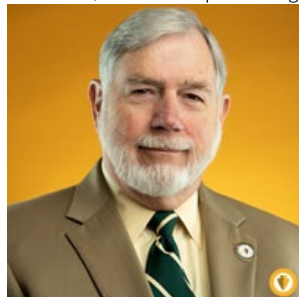

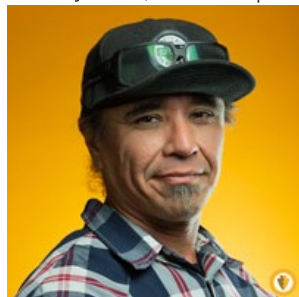
