## MEASURE CC ENSURES OUR COMMUNITY HAS ACCESS TO QUALITY HIGHER EDUCATION AND CAREER TRAINING BY:

- Repairing or replacing leaky roofs, old rusty plumbing and faulty electrical systems

- Upgrading classrooms, STEM labs, and job-training facilities to meet modern career and safety standards, and to keep local colleges in good condition for years to come
- Updating campus security systems
- Improving building access for students with disabilities
- Modernizing student centers to allow job training, placement, counseling and support services to military veterans and their families

#### STRICT TAXPAYER ACCOUNTABILITY

- Independent taxpayer's oversight committee and regular audits will ensure funds are spent as promised
- \$470 million local funds will not be taken away by Sacramento ensuring that every penny will be spent to improve local colleges
- Colleges may qualify for state matching funds to construct safe, secure and up-to-date facilities

#### COMMUNITY BENEFITS AGREEMENT

- The Community Benefits Agreement (CBA) is between the San Bernardino Community College District and the San Bernardino/Riverside Counties Building and Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO , and the signatory Craft Unions.
- Purpose and intent is to achieve the timely, safe, and economical construction of the facilities and to provide opportunities and programs for the Local Residents and Local Businesses to participate.
- Limited to all new construction, rehabilitation, and renovation work with a total cost of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) or more, and for which Measure "M" or Measure "CC" funds are used (which includes, when an integral part of the Project, demolition, site clearing, and hazard abatement work).
