7 **A. Programs**

9 The colleges of the District shall offer comprehensive instructional programs in the areas of
10 general education, transfer education, vocational education, learning skills education,
11 community services, and joint programs with business, industry, labor, government, and
12 other accredited educational institutions.
13

14 **B. Degrees**
15

16 The colleges shall offer programs of instruction leading to the Associate in Arts Degree
17 and/or the Associate in Science Degree. Degree programs shall meet State requirements
18 for such degrees. Each college shall publish the requirements for the degrees offered in its
19 college catalog.
20

21 **C. Certificates**
22

23 The colleges shall offer programs leading to a Certificate of Completion in fields of study or
24 training where such certificates are appropriate.

26 **D. Approval**
27

28 Courses, degrees, and certificate programs require Board approval and approval by the
29 State Chancellor's Office.
