Analysis: In 2017-2018, the college going rate for high school graduates from our feeder districts was $54.6 \%$. This includes all college and university enrollments, both in and out of state. Before SBCCD's College Promise Program, $36 \%$ of high school graduates from feeder districts enrolled in either Crafton Hills College or San Bernardino Valley College. This means that of the 4,916 students who enrolled in college, approximately 3,244 of these students enrolled in our district.
