The Nursing Department

offers a sequence of courses leading to an Associate of Science degree with a major in nursing. Students learn to function in a variety of health care settings and assist patients, through the nursing process, attain or maintain their optimum level of wellness.



Graduates are eligible to take the national licensing exam and become licensed as a Registered Nurse in California.

Learning activities are conducted on the San Bernardino Valley College campus and local hospitals and community agencies. The program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) and approved by the California Board of Registered Nursing (BRN). Nursing Application Evaluations of Prior Credit

Evaluations are required to apply. If evaluations are not complete in time for nursing application, nursing application will not be accepted. Please verify on evaluation if any courses has (*) on them and see note. You do not need 12 units of residency.

Students must submit all official transcripts including Crafton Hills and request for an evaluation during the following dates in order to apply for the nursing program. Transcripts will not be collected in the nursing application. Instead, evaluations of prior credit are required within admissions application.

Registered Nursing Applicants with Outside Transcripts!

If you took an online science course i.e. anatomy/physio or Mirco online the nursing department will not accept the courses. **Although, if the course was taken during the terms of Spring 2020 and Summer 2020 online with previously accepted schools/courses we will make the exception to accept them because of COVID 19.**

If you are using AP credit with a score 3 or higher official college board results must be submitted to Admissions and Records AD/SS-100. All official transcripts must be submitted to the Admissions & Records Office (AD/SS-100) for evaluation of prior credit.

Your Nursing Program Application must contain the Evaluation of Prior College Credits Earned.
