DE Faculty Lead/s and Committee End of AY 2020/2021 Report

The Distance Education Committee has had an active year with great strides made in the area of faculty training, meeting goals of CVC Consortium, and updating websites. Some of the achievements and outcomes of the committee are provided below. These highlights of work completed is not an exhaustive list.

Achievements and Outcomes

- Over 290 faculty trained in Level 1 Online Teaching Training.
- Over 30 faculty trained in Level 2 Online Teaching Training.
- 27 training courses facilitated.
- Level 1 training revised to incorporate accessibility. Latest version launched Spring 2021.
- Level 2 training revisions to focus on Equity and Engagement started, to be launched Fall 2021.
- Established Local Peer Online Course Review (POCR) and certification process.
- Facilitated first and second POCR review cohorts as Beta testing process.
- Completed CTE Online Pathways Grant, which focused on improving online pathways of CTE courses.
- Redesigned and launched student landing page for Online Learning.
- Redesigned and launched faculty landing page for Distance Education.
- Established San Bernardino Valley College as a Home and Teaching College within the state-wide CVC Exchange.
- Attended Online Teaching Conference.
- DE Faculty Leads completed two micro-credentials with A.C.U.E.
- Faculty Leads participated in monthly CVC Consortium meetings.
- Faculty Leads participated in monthly California Community Colleges Distance Education Coordinators Organization.
- Several presentations regarding Distance Education best practices, Title 5 and Ed Code regulations, regular and effective interaction, accessibility, and humanization of online instruction were presented throughout the year in coordination with Professional Development.
